

It is important to understand that the number of Air Force civilian positions available to United States citizens in foreign areas are significantly lower than the number available in the United States. In addition, the agreements between the United States and host countries, which govern our presence in the respective countries, require that many of the positions be authorized for and filled by Nationals of the host country; consequently, the number of positions available to United States citizens is further limited. In some areas, opportunities for employment may exist in Air Force Nonappropriated Funds (NAF) or the Department of Defense Dependent Schools (DoDDS). Other sources for employment may include the Army and Air Force Exchange Service, on base banks, credit unions or other establishments providing services to United States forces. You would have to contact each organization's personnel office for vacancy information. (Ref: AFPAM 36-508)
