

ID Card Requirements for Students

Do you have college children taking a break for summer? If the dependent student needs an ID card during summer break: per ID Card regulation AFI 36-3026, procedures for students over 21, but less than 23 years of age enrolled full-time: a letter from the school is required certifying the student was full time during the semester or session immediately preceding the break and has been accepted or is pre-enrolled as a full-time student for the semester or session immediately after the break.

It is important this letter and a copy of the student's birth certificate are provided when the sponsor fills out the ID card request application. Otherwise the application for the ID card can not be processed.

The sponsor must also sign a statement on DD Form 1172 certifying that he or she provides over 50% of the student's financial support.
