Fact Sheet: Passport Renewals--- Military Retirees

Option #1: Visit the Citizen Services at the Embassy website. Just go to: http://germany.usembassy.gov/acs/passportrenewalbymail_adult/

You can fill out application on-line (Form DS-82) and use the mail in program to the American Consulate in Frankfurt but you have to follow their simple mailing instructions.

At the time of your passport application, either in-person or by mail, you must have a **prepaid courier envelope** in your possession. While any pre-paid, pre-addressed courier envelope is acceptable, we strongly encourage applicants to use **Deutsche Post's Express Brief (DHL)**. For security reasons they no longer accept Einschreiben or ordinary postage.

Please note that ordinary mail cannot be tracked, and is not secure.

Option # 2: Complete the DS Form 82, obtain correct size photographs, required money order, old passports, and visit the Army's Kleber Kaserne Office, Building 3245, See Attached Elver from IMCOM "Adult Tourist" sheet outlining information stated
