Transition Goals, Plan, Success (T-GPS) WORKSHOPS

Veterans Opportunity to Work (VOW) Act of 2011 is a congressionally mandatory transition assistance program that has four key elements that all active duty members must complete prior to separating or retiring.

- 1. Attend a Pre-Separation Counseling briefing (DD 2648) prior to attending T-GPS.
- 2. Attend VA Benefits I & II briefings (part of 5 day T-GPS course).
- 3. Attend 3 day DOL Employment Workshop (part of 5 day T-GPS course).

Note: One day of the 5 day program is designated to help you complete Career Readiness Standards required for CAPSTONE.

4. Complete a CAPSTONE (DD 2958) within a 120 days of separation/retirement.
