SUBJECT: REVISED AMC POLICY ON PROHIBITED ITEMS (LIQUIDS, AEROSOLS, AND GELS).

REFERENCE: DMS MESSAGE, NEWLY PUBLISHED AIR MOBILITY COMMAND GUIDELINES FOR SCREENING PASSENGERS, DTG 102230Z AUG 06.

PLEASE ENSURE WIDEST DISSEMINATION TO ALL AMC PASSENGER TERMINALS, TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT OFFICES, INSTALLATION TRANSPORTATION OFFICES, DOD TRAVELERS, AND COMMERCIAL TRAVEL OFFICES.

1. TSA HAS REVISED THEIR BAN ON LIQUIDS, AEROSOLS, AND GELS. TWO MAJOR CHANGES ARE EFFECTIVE TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2006. THESE NEW PROCEDURES APPLY TO ALL AMC-OWNED OR OPERATED PASSENGER TERMINALS IAW AMCI 24-101, VOLS 14 AND 15.

A. TRAVELERS MAY NOW CARRY THE FOLLOWING ITEMS THROUGH SECURITY CHECKPOINTS: TRAVEL-SIZE TOILETRIES (3 OUNCES OR LESS) THAT FIT COMFORTABLY IN A SINGLE ONE QUART SIZE, CLEAR PLASTIC, ZIP-TOP BAG. THE BAG SHOULD BE NO LARGER THAN 8 INCHES BY 7.5 INCHES. ADDITIONALLY, PASSENGERS MUST DECLARE LARGER AMOUNTS OF PRESCRIPTION LIQUID MEDICATIONS, BABY FORMULA, AND DIABETIC GLUCOSE TREATMENTS AT THE SECURITY CHECKPOINT FOR ADDITIONAL SCREENING. AT THE SECURITY CHECKPOINT, SCREENERS WILL ASK TRAVELERS TO REMOVE THE ZIP-LOCK BAG OF LIQUIDS AND PLACE IT IN A BIN OR ON THE CONVEYOR BELT.

B. SINGLE POINT OF ENTRY (SPE) TERMINALS: SCREENERS MUST PERFORM ADDITIONAL PASSENGER SCREENING PRIOR TO BOARDING SINCE PASSENGERS HAVE ACCESS TO ALL THEIR CHECKED BAGGAGE AFTER PASSING THROUGH THE SPE.

C. TRAVELERS MAY BRING BEVERAGES AND OTHER ITEMS ABOARD THE AIRCRAFT ONLY IF THEY PURCHASED THE ITEMS WITHIN THE STERILE/SECURE BOARDING AREA.
