CURRENT SITUATION IN RHINELAND-PALATINATE

Wednesday May 27, 2020

+++ State Parliamentary Meeting in Rheingoldhalle - Government Policy Statement +++ 7 a.m.

After two meetings took place under strict restrictions the state parliament will gather in full number for the first time again. At the beginning of the two-day meeting Prime Minister Malu Dreyer (SPD) will address protective measures against corona pandemic.

+++ Many Leisure Activities are allowed again +++ 6.15 a.m.

Effective today people in Rhineland-Palatinate may go to the cinemas, fitness studios or to outdoor pools again. Flea markets and other outside events up to 100 participants are authorized. The state published respective hygiene ordinances.

Tuesday May 26, 2020

+++ Another 35 Corona Cases in Refugee Lodgings in Mainz +++ 9.45 p.m.

35 residents of the refugee lodgings in Allianz Building in the City of Mainz tested positive for corona virus. This is what Public Health Office of Mainz-Bingen revealed Tuesday evening. The house has been under quarantine since last Tuesday (May 19) after a resident family tested positive and after more cases on different floors were identified thereafter. Following, all residence quarantined in Allianz Building were tested for COVID-19.

+++ Contact Restrictions are extended +++ 9.15 p.m.

Contact restrictions due to corona virus pandemic are extended until June 29. That was agreed upon by the federation and the states according to the Federal Press Authority in Berlin Tuesday evening. Effective June 6 the states may authorize easing, e.g. a maximum of ten persons from two households are allowed to meet in public.
