GOVERNMENT POLICY STATEMENT IN STATE PARLIAMENT MAINZ

SWR Extra Live: Dreyer will give Statement about Corona Crisis

Corona restrictions in Rhineland-Palatinate will be loosened. Prime Minister of the State of Rhineland-Palatinate, Malu Dreyer (SPD), will address the extent of the easing and the current situation in her policy statement.



Besides recent measures for loosening of restrictions Dreyer will also address the financial impact on the state and the communities. The opposition clearly criticized the state's anti-corona measures prior to the meeting. Christian Baldauf commented implementation of the measures: "From our point of view things do not run smoothly but rather bad."

By request of CDU several parliamentary groups jointly want to set up a working group for corona precautions and remedial measures.

Besides that the current report about the Constitutional Protection Service and on agronomics in crisis will also get debated. And the assembly will first discuss plans for restructuring of universities.

Parliamentary Meeting in Rheingoldhalle

This is the first time representatives will meet in Rheingoldhalle for a session and for the subsequent discussion because this assembly hall is spacious enough and allows representatives to comply with physical distancing during corona crisis.

After two parliamentary meetings took place with a reduced number of representatives the Rheingoldhalle allows members of parliament to meet in full number and still comply with health protection provisions.
