Hygiene concept for Gaming/Gambling Facilities

- 1. The applicable distance requirements and contact restrictions are guaranteed by the following measures:
 - a. Guests are informed of access restrictions, distance rules and hygiene requirements by highly visible, multilingual signs and pictograms.
 - b. Access restrictions must ensure that the maximum amount of people isn't exceeded, as far as the respective Corona Control Ordinance does not stipulate another regulation. The distance requirements inside buildings must be met.
 - c. Persons must keep 1.5 meter distance (employees and guests). This is to be achieved by markings on waiting area floors. The minimum distance rule does not apply if guests are separated by partitions.

Measures to control access and to meet the distance requirement must be taken, including, where necessary, appropriately signposted route concepts.

2. Organization of the operation:

- a. Visitor contact details (last name, first name, address, telephone number) and the time of entering and leaving the gaming/gambling facility are to be collected from all guests by the owner and will be kept for a period of 1 month starting on the day of the visit and subsequently destroyed in compliance with the data protection law. Processing the data for other purposes is not permitted.
- b. Only one guest may play at a machine.
- c. Catering may take place under the specifications for the catering trade.
- 3. Individual measures relating to persons:
 - a. Access to persons with symptoms of a respiratory infection has to be denied.
 - b. All persons must disinfect or wash their hands when entering the facility. Appropriate facilities or disinfectants must be provided by the owener.
 - c. Guests and employees must wear a mouth-nose cover, as far as the Corona Control Ordinance in the currently applicable version mandates this.
 - d. Cashier personnel protected by a plexiglass pane or other appropriate measure are exempt from wearing mouth and nose covering.
 - e. Current infection protection rules must be posted.

4. Institution-related measures:

- a. Targeted measures must be taken to minimize the contamination of rooms with aerosols. All rooms are to be adequately ventilated.
- b. Gaming machines as well as tables, chairs and shelves are to be cleaned or disinfected after each player and at regular intervals.
- c. Sanitary facilities, common and break rooms must be equipped with disinfectant, liquid soap and disposable towels.

5. In general:

- a. A responsible person must be appointed on site to ensure compliance with the regulations.
- b. Individuals who are not prepared to comply with these rules are to be denied access within the framework of the domestic authority.
- c. In addition and upon request, the responsible authority can, in justified individual cases, allow exceptions or other hygiene requirements if a requirement under a corona ordinance is not mandatory, the level of protection appears comparable and the purpose of the corona ordinance is observed.
