

Hygiene concept for forest and wilderness educational offers and events (as of 16 Sep 20)

The following hygiene measures must be observed for all forest and wilderness educational offers:

1. The following measures guarantee the valid distance rule and the valid contact restriction:

a. The limitation of the number of persons of the Corona control regulation in the valid version applies.

b. The distance of at least 1.5 meters per person shall be ensured, unless the respectively applicable Corona Control Ordinance provides otherwise. Measures to control access and to maintain the distance requirement shall be taken.

c. If an increased aerosol emission is to be expected due to the type of activity, the minimum distance shall be doubled.

2. Organization of the event:

The contact traceability of the participants present shall be ensured. Contact data (surname, first name, address, telephone number), which ensure that the person can be reached, as well as the date and time of the person's presence shall be collected by the organizer in compliance with the provisions of data protection law and kept for a period of one month; after the expiration of the retention period, the data shall be deleted immediately.

a. Jointly used facilities, in particular showers and changing rooms, are exclusively released for use alone or by family members of one household.

b. Catering may be provided in accordance with the regulations for gastronomy.

c. A distance of at least 3 meters must be maintained between information and sales stands.

3. Individual personal measures:

a. Persons with recognizable symptoms of a respiratory tract infection shall be denied access.

b. All persons must disinfect or wash their hands when entering the event. Suitable washing facilities or disinfection dispensers are to be provided by the organizer.

c. The applicable protective measures and rules of conduct (including general rules of infection protection such as "sneezing label", classification of cold symptoms, etc.) must be indicated by appropriate signs.

d. Visitors as well as employees wear a mouth-nose cover, as far as the Corona control ordinance in the valid version arranges this.

e. Renting of items is not permitted if they cannot be disinfected after use.

4. Event related measures:

a. Hand disinfectants, liquid soap and disposable towels must be provided in sanitary, common and break rooms. The rooms must be cleaned regularly.

b. Specific measures shall be taken to minimize the exposure of rooms to aerosols. All rooms must be adequately ventilated

5. Generally, it applies that :

a. a responsible person must be appointed on site to ensure compliance with the regulations

b. persons who are not willing to comply with these rules are to be excluded from the event.

c. In addition, the competent authority may, in justified individual cases and upon application, allow exceptions or impose other hygiene requirements, provided that a specification according to CoBeLVO is not mandatory, the level of protection appears comparable and the purpose of CoBeLVO is complied with.
