One of the strengths of the School Liaison program is **connections**. All School Liaisons work together to provide consistent support for families and students throughout the world. No matter where your military service takes you next, we'll be there to help your family.

School Meal Program

All students who enroll in a DoDEA school will automatically have a School Meal account with Aafes upon completion of the registration process.

PAYMENTS

A LINQ Connect account needs to be set up by the sponsor/guardian in order to access a student's school lunch account. You will need your student's 10-digit DoDEA student ID in order to start the process at <https://linqconnect.com>. The account will allow for you to monitor and manage your child's lunch account online. Low balance notifications, setting up restrictions on what the student can purchase and online payments are just a couple features of the account.

Payments can also be made at the local Exchange Main Store Customer Service or at your school's cafeteria.
