School Meal Program

AAFES administers the Student Meal Program within the KMC DoDEA schools. Parents can open a student lunch account through liqconnect.com. Search for and click on AAFES DODEA. This will take you to the Letter of Household. Please read and click Next. Enter information, please note that an email address is required for communicating eligibility status. Click New Student, and enter as much information as possible. Click save. If there are other students that attend this school district, please repeat the steps above to add them to application then click next. Enter the total number of people in your household, including students.

Free & Reduced Priced Lunch Program

Program eligibility is based on total household size and income. (BAH and COLA are NOT included as family income; however, BAS is.)
