MAJOR BENJAMIN W. LEUNG

Major Benjamin W. Leung is the Commander, 65th Logistics Readiness Squadron, Lajes Field, Azores, Portugal. His unit is responsible for providing logistic support to the 65th Air Base Group and allied forces operating in and throughout the Atlantic Ocean area of operations. Major Leung directs repair and maintenance of a 194-vehicle fleet sustaining both the military installation and Lajes International Airport. He leads a team of 90 military and civilian personnel in providing supply chain, transportation, cargo handling, passenger travel, and contingency planning support to the base. Major Leung oversees the managing of over \$1 billion in real property, a 36-million-gallon tank farm, and the United States Air Forces in Europe's only seaport tanker pier, fueling flightline operations and Portuguese Air Force search and rescue missions across 2 million square miles of the Atlantic Ocean.

Major Leung commissioned in 2011 from the United States Air Force Academy as a Logistics Readiness Officer. He has led the Fuels Management Flight at Ramstein Air Base (AB), the Vehicle Management Flight at Osan AB, and the Air Terminal Operations Center at Mildenhall AB. He has deployed as the Installation Deployment Officer to Ahmad al-Jaber AB in Kuwait, and the AFCENT A4 Forward in Al Udeid AB in Qatar. He has completed his master's degree in Logistics and Supply Chain Management from the Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT).

Prior to his current assignment, Major Leung was the Operations Officer for the 56th Logistics Readiness Squadron (LRS), where he coordinated the support for the largest AETC fighter base supporting the F-1, F-16, and F-35 platforms.
