



Disposal of domestic waste that may be contaminated with coronavirus in the city and county of Kaiserslautern

- 1. Potentially coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2) infected waste from private households must, without exception, be disposed of in the container for non-recyclable waste (black can).
- 2. To avoid putting waste collectors or people using the same waste can at risk, it is **prohibited to dump contaminated items loosely** in the can.
- 3. This waste must be wrapped in **tear- and moisture-proof sacks** (e.g. plastic or garbage bags) and **sealed tightly**, for instance with a knot. If required, use several bags and discard the bagged up waste in the black can.
- 4. **Put pointed or sharp items** in unbreakable, non-penetrable disposal boxes (e.g. sharps containers).
- 5. Under no circumstances may sacks or loose items be placed next to the waste can or container where they are accessible to others.
- 6. Items that do not fit in the black can must be wrapped carefully and stored in a place not accessible to other persons or animals until pick-up.

In case the health authority passes other stipulations, compliance to these stipulations is mandatory!
